

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be spending time supporting the children to settle and form new friendships. We will spend time discussing our families and those people who are important to us.

You can help at home by...

Sharing family photos of special celebrations or events.
Talking about your immediate and extended family.

Literacy

We will begin to learn to link sounds and letters of the alphabet using the 'Jolly Phonics' and Letters and Sounds schemes. We will support the children to build on their emergent writing and focus on hearing sounds in words.

You can help at home by...

Listening to the different sounds you can hear in your home/ on a walk and try to create these sound using their mouth or body.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will have lots of opportunities to use their imagination and creativity as we role play familiar experiences and stories. They will have opportunities to explore different media and materials such as painting, collage, clay and modelling.

You can help at home by ...

Encouraging your child to talk about what they have drawn/made. Talking to your child about the games you played when you were a child.

Communication and Language

We will be supporting the children to listen to stories and answer key questions about what we have read. We will be enjoying stories and rhymes with the children daily.

You can help at home by...

Sharing a book with your child every day and talking about the story. For new stories encourage your child to predict what might happen next.

Physical Development

To develop coordination, gross motor skills and spatial awareness. We will be dancing and playing with toys outside to develop these. Children will engage in a range of fine motor activities such as threading, using tweezers to pick up small objects and modelling with dough/clay.

You can help at home by...

Visiting a local park and using the equipment to develop muscle strength. For example, climbing frames or monkey bars.

Mathematics

We will be teaching the children to count to 20, counting sets of objects and ordering numbers.

You can help at home by...

Going on a number walk, collecting leaves in the park and counting and sorting, talking about numbers and comparing bigger and smaller numbers.
