

<p>The topic this half term is called <b>Prophecy and Promise</b>. Children will explore two key themes: the structure of the Mass and the Nativity in St Matthew's Gospel. The focus on the Liturgy of the Word, learning how Christians gather, listen to Scripture, and respond in faith, linking this to Creation themes such as gift and rest. They also study Matthew's account of the Nativity, recognising Jesus as the fulfilment of Jewish prophecy and the long-awaited Messiah. Children reflect on the symbolic meaning of Bethlehem and its link to King David and the Eucharist. This Branch will deepen their understanding of the Mass and how Scripture is lived and celebrated in the Church.</p>		<p><b>As Readers</b>, we will explore dictionaries, discussing what they are and how they are used. We will be reading Oliver and the Seawigs as our class text. We will discuss the characters and how they are portrayed by the author. We will also discuss the themes explored in the book.</p> <p><b>As Writers</b>, We will communicate effectively through letters and diary entries. Make our own non fiction texts to be published thinking carefully about our organisation and layout. Write in role as characters from our class text and explore techniques used to create exciting characters.</p>		<p>Counting, sequences, multiplication facts. Revise multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Count from 0 in multiples of 3, 4 and 8. Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3 and 4 and 8 times tables. Written and mental multiplication. <p><b>Stop-frame animation</b></p> <p>Learners will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. Next, they will apply those skills to create a story-based animation.
