<p>As Scientists we will look at the growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. We will build on learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter.</p>	<p>In the Magnificent Monarchs project, we will learn about English and British monarchs from AD 871 to the present day and consider how the power of the monarchy has changed over time. We will study six significant sovereigns; Alfred the Great, William the Conqueror, Henry VIII, Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Elizabeth II. Finally, we will choose which of the sovereigns that they have studied is the most significant.</p>		<p>As Artists we will develop ideas from a variety of starting points including the natural world, man-made objects, fantasy and stories. We will develop our sketching techniques and understand why portraits were used in the past and their significance.</p>	<p>Health and Wellbeing The focus of the learning is to consolidate our understanding of agility and when this is applied during sport. Pupils will develop different ways of moving at speed and will understand the consequences of not being agile.</p> <p>Ball Skills: Hands The focus of learning is to develop dribbling in order to keep control and possession of the ball.</p>
