In the name of the Father

1. **Touch your forehead:** As you say "In the name of the Father".
2. **Move to your chest or stomach:** Then say "and of the Son".
3. **Move from your left shoulder to your right shoulder:** As you say "and of the Holy Spirit".
4. **Conclude with "Amen":** after bringing your hand back to your chest or stomach, a symbol of the completed cross.

for ever**

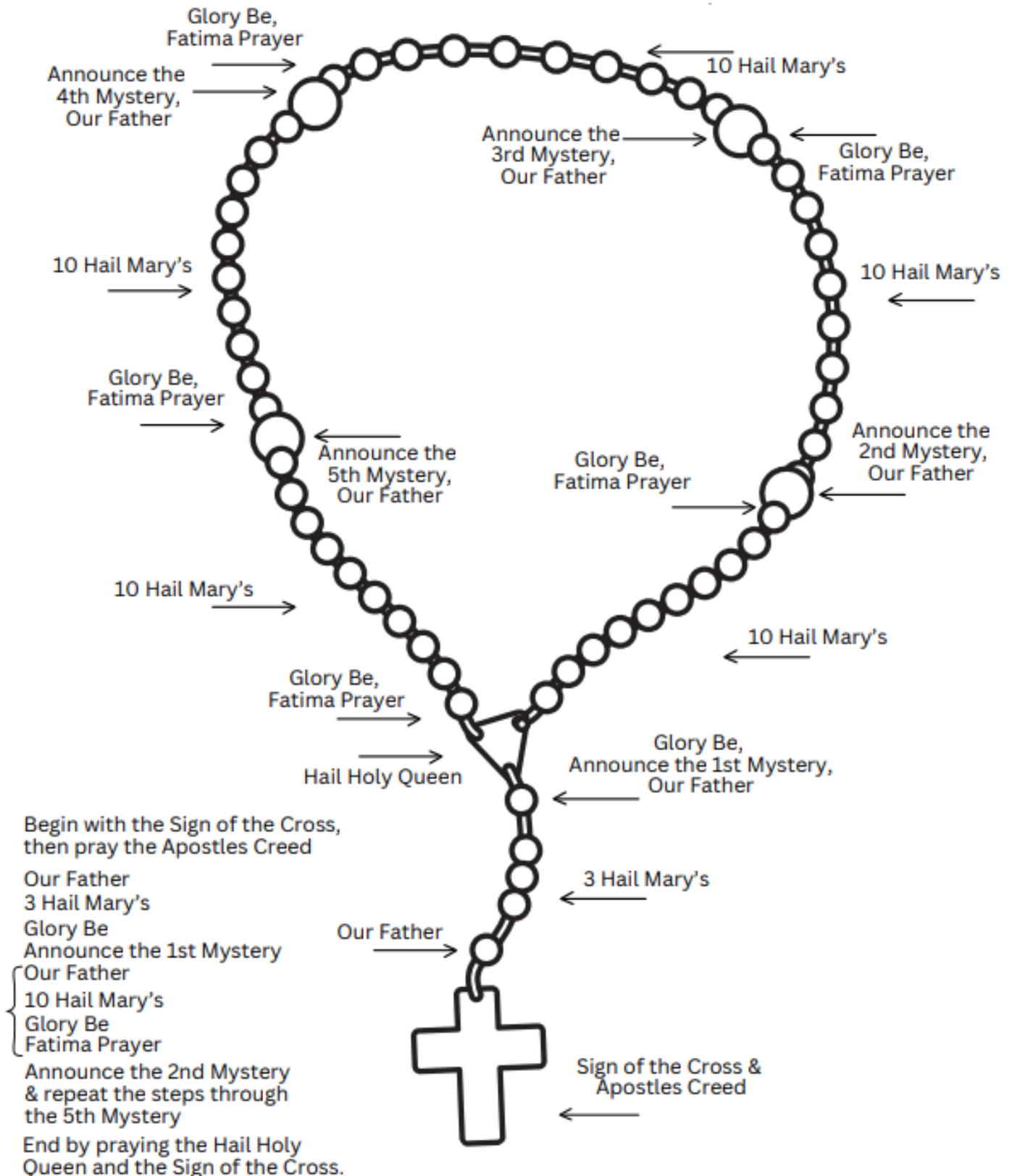
